

Antonio Carámbula Sagasti has been CEO of Instituto Uruguay XXI since March 2015.

Antonio holds a Doctorate degree in Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Technology from the University of the Republic.

He has completed postgraduate studies in Business Administration at the Catholic University of Uruguay.

In 2005, he was appointed by the President of the Republic, Dr. Tabaré Vazquez as Director General of the Secretariat within the Ministry of Tourism and Sports.

In 2010, President José Mujica reappointed him to the position until May 2012, when he was appointed Deputy Secretary of the Ministry of Tourism and Sports, office he held until February 2015.

He has been the representative of the Ministry of Tourism and Sports at the National Aeronautics Board, the National Drugs Board and Vice-President of the Committee for the Elimination of Violence in Sports.

Between 1995 and 2005, he served as Secretary of the Local Community Board No.1, appointed by the Mayor of Montevideo, Architect Mariano Arana, as Director of the Central Region Division of the City Government of Montevideo and as Director of the “Ciudad Vieja Urban Rehabilitation Plan”.
