Manos del Uruguay

Manos del Uruguay is a non-profit organization that provides work to women in rural areas of the country. We hand-knit, hand-weave, hand-spin, and hand-dye utilizing uruguay's natural wool resources.





Estancia Mendoza Deco Wool

Estancia Mendoza Deco Wool is a Uruguayan brand that blends timeless design with artisan tradition. We create high-quality wool products for home and fashion, handcrafted by rural women using natural, sustainable materials. Each piece carries the essence of our land, cultural heritage, and commitment to fair trade and environmental care.



María Kessler

María Kessler creates handmade rugs and tapestries with time and dedication, crafting unique pieces made from wool. These works, beyond the design, are created through the connection between the person and the moment in which the piece is being created. Ultimately, the process is what matters most in the final product.



SATORI - Jimena Risso

Satori is my textile art practice, a space where material, body, and inner transformation converge. I work with sheep wool and natural fibers, using wet felting as my primary technique. My approach is rooted in slow, intuitive, and manual processes. I'm interested in what emerges from touch, repetition, and imperfection — where residue and persistence become part of the language.



Nido_Kidswear

Nido was born in 2021 as an artisanal children's clothing brand that expresses a sentiment for the past with a modern update. We work with artisanal techniques that evoke love in the design and craftsmanship of each Nido piece.



Texturable

Texturable is a women-led textile studio based in Uruguay, dedicated to crafting handspun and handwoven wool pieces for the home. Rooted in sustainability and ancestral techniques, our work celebrates the beauty of natural materials, simple luxury, and the power of slow, intentional making



La Pasionaria

La Pasionaria is a Montevideo-based atelier where Paulina and Rossana craft unique pieces using noble fibers like merino wool, alpaca, and silk, since 2008. Inspired by nature and artisanal traditions, they design timeless objects that convey beauty, well-being, and authentic connection.



Engraw

Engraw is a family-owned wool combing mill in Uruguay, established in 1951. It processes mulesing-free wool (17–32 microns) from local and regional breeds, working with regenerative Land to Market verified growers. Engraw uses 98% renewable energy and holds Cradle to Cradle, RWS, GOTS, OEKO-TEX, and carbon counting certifications.



Ound

This is a project about nature, about silk dyed with handmade pigments obtained from food waste and plants, and about hand-knitted undyed wool.
