In her role as Process Coordinator, she actively participated in the integral design of the platform (implemented in 2013), reviewing the foreign trade processes and the regulations that govern them in order to incorporate technology that allowed to have a single platform to manage import, export and transit procedures. As Operations Coordinator, she continued analyzing the processes of the agencies involved, detecting opportunities for improvement and advising on the use of best practices, thus reinforcing the commitment to continuous improvement.

He is currently leading the SW, designing together with the management team, its strategy and model, defining the objectives, initiatives, the conformation and management of the work team, the development of the platform and its implementation, as well as the definition of the institutional and regulatory aspects. He also collaborates in strategies for change management, as well as the definition of communication aspects.

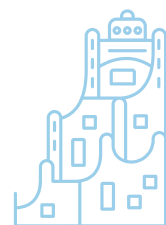
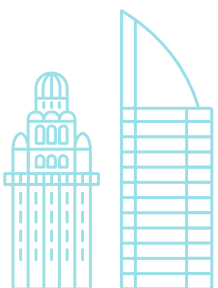
