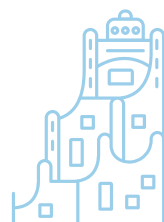
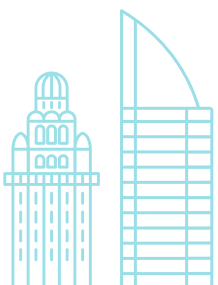
He actively participated in the design and implementation of the platform (implemented in 2013) and the information systems that support the VUCE. He is part of the management team collaborating in the design of the strategic objectives, the conformation and management of the work team (incorporating agile methodologies), the development of the platform and its implementation.

He actively participates in the Inter-American Network of SWs as representative of Uruguay, where he has made presentations on the topics "Advances and challenges in the implementation of SWs within and outside the region" and "Impact of SWs on Trade and Competitiveness" as well as moderating panels.

During 2013 and 2014, he participated in the Data Harmonization working group created by the Inter-American Network of SWs to carry out the analysis of the GAP in terms of the information needed to make interoperability between windows feasible.

It leads the integration of the Digital Certificate of Origin (COD) with the Pacific Alliance from the side of SW Uruguay and participates in the integration of COD MERCOSUR together with ALADI and IDB.

He has provided support to the governments of Bolivia and Venezuela in the diagnosis of the needs of the SWs and in the design of their solutions, sharing the experiences and lessons learned during the process in Uruguay.



He is trained in foreign trade by the Chamber of Commerce and Services of Uruguay. He has specific courses on the implementation of Single Windows as a tool for trade facilitation, legislation (The legal aspects of electronic commerce for Latin America and the Caribbean) and practices of trade agreements (New Trends in Trade Agreements in Latin America - in progress), taught by IDB, CEDET and UNCTAD.

He is a Systems Analyst and Systems Engineer from ORT Uruguay University and holds a Master's Degree in Management of Technological Companies (MBA and MoT). He has experience in cooperative work teams, national and international, in projects distributed in different countries both in the public and private sector.
