Marinés Cardozo has been a Legal Affairs Specialist at the Foreign Trade Single Window (VUCE) at the investment, export and country brand promotion agency, Uruguay XXI since 2012.

She participated in the regulatory survey for the integral design of the platform (implemented in 2013) leading the study of the regulations of each Agency that is integrated to the VUCE, being able to propose its systematization. Likewise, she advised on the recommendations regarding the institutional framework of the SW, actively participating in the drafting of the articles for its creation (Law 19.149).

Currently, she is responsible for the preparation of draft laws, decrees and resolutions that contribute to the proper functioning of the platform, as well as advising the technical team on regulatory aspects related to the implementation of procedures.

She has developed skills that allow SW to maintain fluid contact with different actors of the public and private sector, promoting negotiations and working agreements, promoting normative and regulatory transformations and accompanying improvement projects in processes that involve the redesign and incorporation of technologies.

She actively participates in the SW Referent Network as the person in charge of inter-institutional relations, where, on a quarterly basis, the platform's user organizations meet to learn about progress and new projects, being a space in which opinions are exchanged. She represents VUCE in the WTO Trade Facilitation Committee where VUCE is an invited member and collaborates in the implementation of the Treaty in Uruquay.















She has taken courses on "Customs and the Trade Facilitation Agreement (WCO)", "Legal Aspects of Electronic Commerce for Latin America and the Caribbean (IDB)", "Electronic Single Windows as Trade Facilitation Tools (IDB), IV International Seminar on Access to Public Information. Challenges of Documentary Management in Digital Government (AGESIC)", among others.

She holds a PhD in Law and Social Sciences, graduated in 2011 from the Universidad de la República. She has vast experience in Foreign Trade, starting her professional activity in the National Customs Directorate, where she was part of the team that led the implementation of the Single Window for Foreign Trade - VUCE, one of the most representative e-government initiatives in recent years, in terms of transformation of the Uruguayan State.
